Scholarship Criteria

The following criteria apply to all scholarship applicants. If specific criteria cannot be met, please provide an explanation.

1. Information on the form (opposite side) must be complete.
2. Applicant must be a senior at a La Plata County high school or charter school and meet the graduation requirements.
3. A grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 is required.
4. Applicant must attend a two or four-year college or technical school.
5. Applicant must participate in an interview with representatives of the Energy Council.
6. Applicant must provide a personal profile that describes yourself, your intended major, career objectives, long-term goals, outside activities, and why this scholarship is important to you.
7. Applicant must provide letters as specified below.

Aulbert Memorial Scholarship Criteria

In addition to the above list of criteria, applicants for the Aulbert Memorial Scholarship must provide two letters of recommendation; one from a teacher or counselor and another from a principal, coach, employer or other non-parent adult.

Scholarship Process

- Deadline for application submissions is March 24th.
- Applicants meeting the criteria will be contacted for an interview.
- After the interview, scholarship selections will be made.
- All applicants will be contacted regarding the scholarship awards prior to graduation and will provide a current photograph.
- \$1,000 scholarship checks will be deposited in the student's tuition accounts prior to Fall Semester.
